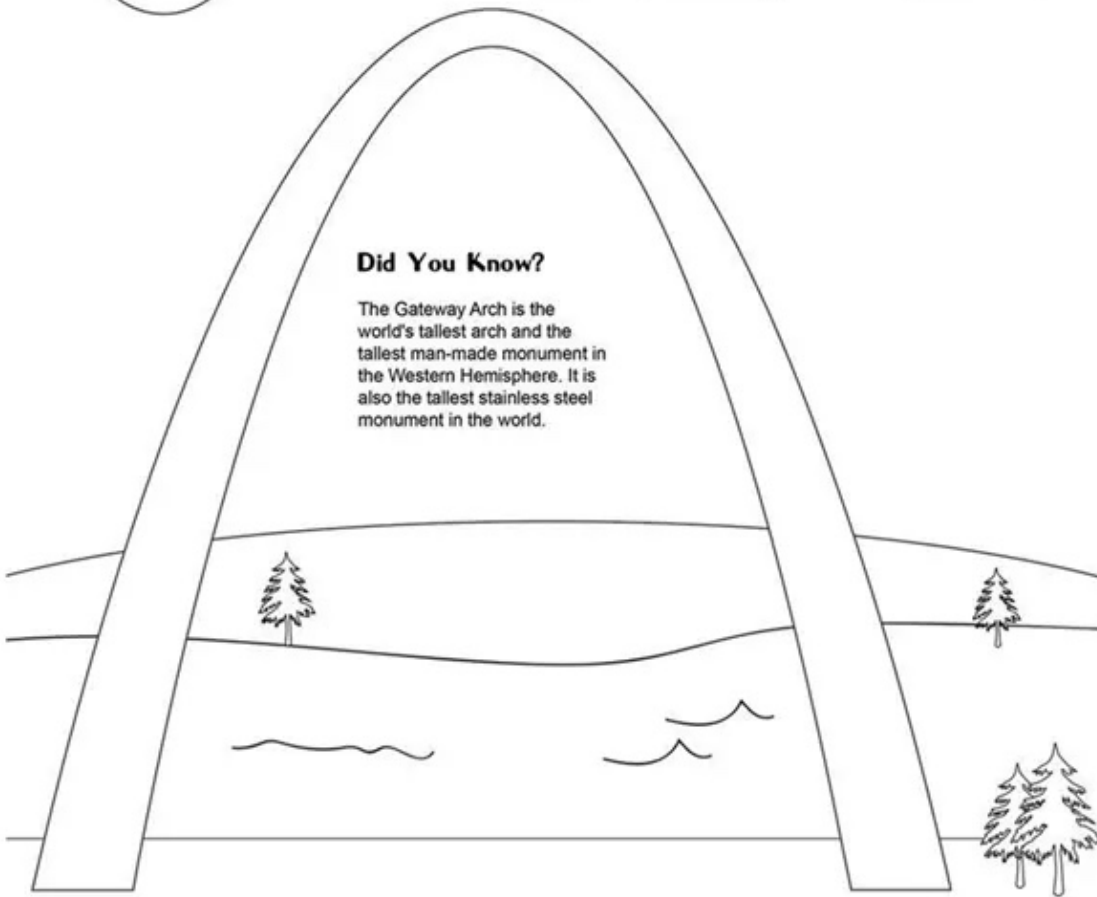


Gateway Arch

The Gateway Arch is the world's tallest arch and the tallest man-made monument in the Western Hemisphere. It is also the tallest stainless steel monument in the world.



Height: The Gateway Arch is a 630-foot monument in St. Louis.

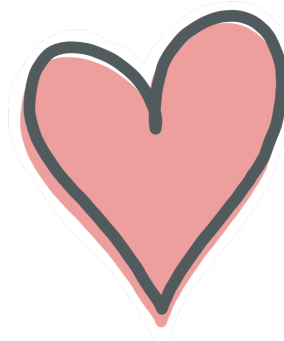
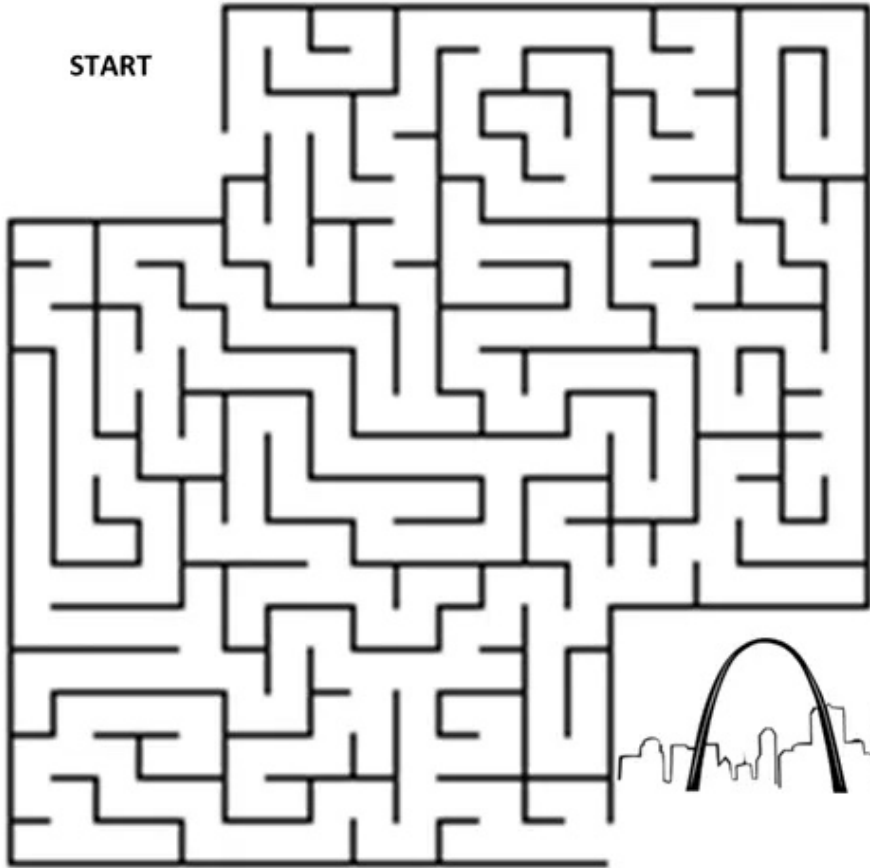
Design: Renowned Finnish-American architect Eero Saarinen won the design contest with his concept of a stainless steel arch.

Construction: Began in 1963 and was completed on October 28, 1965





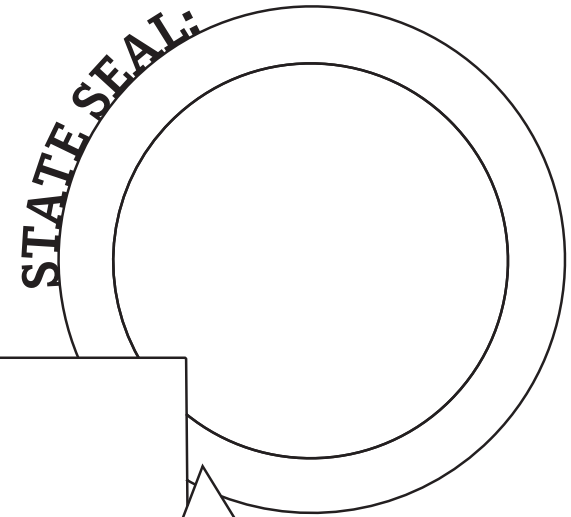
